## White Wine

- Marques Calado Macabeo (Spain)** **£16.50**  
Fresh floral aromas reminiscent of aromatic herbs such as anise & fennel, the smooth & velvety palate is fruit driven with citrus & banana characteristics.
- Big Bombora Chardonnay (Australia)** **£17.75**  
Pale straw yellow with youthful green hues. A nose of citrus fruits & ripe apples, with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon & lime on the palate, served up with a rounded & buttery feel.
- Vina Carrasco Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)** **£17.75**  
Thoroughly citrusy on the nose, with fresh lime and lemon forming the aromatic backdrop. More citrus on the palate, accompanied by a riper hint of pineapple, and mouth watering acidity.
- Alfredini Pinot Grigio Garganega (Italy)** **£18.50**  
Light in colour, refreshing, & crisp with aromas of limes, grapefruits & lemons making this well balanced wine very easy to drink.
- Fathom's Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand)** **£21.50**  
Typical of Kiwi Sauvignon, the bouquet springs from the glass, offering plumes of citrus, green grass and elderflower. The palate is a burst of crisp grapefruit & gooseberry flavours.
- Baron de Baussac Viognier PGI Pays d'oc (France)** **£21.50**  
Most of the grapes for this wine come from vineyards near Minervois in the North-East of the Languedoc. Fresh and dry with aromas of apricot and white peach, hints of elderflower and fresh pineapple. A refreshing crisp acidity draws it all together beautifully.
- Saint Clair Pioneer Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough** **£30.50**  
An almost otherworldly intensity of fruit, with pungent aromas of gooseberry and passionfruit, with a steely dryness, herbaceous characters, underlying minerality and a long lingering finish.
- Chablis, Philippe de Mery** **£29.50**  
Lively and fresh with clean citrus aromas. Crisp, fruity and steely dry on the palate. The finish is long and lean.

## Red Wine

<b>Marques Calado Tempranillo (Spain)</b>	<b>£16.50</b>
Classic Tempranillo notes of dark cherry and blackcurrant are lifted by a hint of dried flowers and sweet spice. Superbly balanced, the fruits of the forest flavours are perfectly complemented by soft tannins.	
<b>Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Grifone (Italy)</b>	<b>£18.50</b>
This is a good quality, medium bodied wine with lots of red cherry fruit & soft supple tannins.	
<b>Big Bombora Shiraz (Australia)</b>	<b>£17.75</b>
A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit & savoury, earthy notes on the nose. The palate is succulent & mouth-filling, with lashings of red berry & brambles.	
<b>Vina Carrasso Merlot (Chile)</b>	<b>£18.50</b>
Aromas of ripe plum and strawberries, with faint notes of tomato leaf and sage. The palate has a thick and jammy feel with soft mature tannins and a rounded easy style.	
<b>Torre Aldea Rioja (Spain)</b>	<b>£19.95</b>
A deep bright red cherry colour with persistent aromas of ripe fruit and berries. Long and lingering with great harmony and a wonderful aftertaste.	
<b>Claro Reserva Pinot Noir (Chile)</b>	<b>£20.50</b>
A richly fruity Pinot Noir, full of ripe strawberry and redcurrant flavours, supported by subtle notes of dried mixed herbs and woodsmoke. Medium weight with soft and pliant tannins.	
<b>Aires Andinos Malbec (Argentina)</b>	<b>£19.50</b>
Deep ruby in colour, aromas of raspberry and plum are complemented by a touch of spice. The concentration of the wine performs well above its price point with soft tannins and a long finish.	

## Rosé

<b>Marques Calado Rose (Spain)</b> An intense pink wine with plenty of juicy berry fruit. Strawberry and Raspberry flavours are complimented by a creamy texture & crisp, refreshing acidity.	<b>£16.50</b>

<b>Cava Calamino (Spain)</b> Fresh and Harmonious displaying plenty of apple & toast flavours. Yet intensely dry & mouth-watering.	<b>£20.00</b>
<b>Prosecco Corte Alta NV, DOC (Italy)</b> Delicate & aromatic with a light body & fine bubbles, this wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot & apple with a revitalising finish.	<b>£23.95</b>
<b>Rabosa Rosado Corte Alta (Italy)</b> An elegant and intense bouquet, dry and soft with fresh peach and red berry flavours on the palate and a round and full bodied structure	<b>£23.95</b>

## Champagne

<b>Veuve Monsigny Champagne Brut</b> Delicious dry yet gentle on the palette. Punches above its weight.	<b>£24.95</b>
<b>Canard-Duchene Brut NV (France)</b> Excellent value for this fabulous & well respected Champagne. Clean & fruity in style, with baked bread & bruised apple notes, fresh & easy drinking.	<b>£37.95</b>
<b>Perrier-Jouet Grand Brut NV (France)</b> The style is friendly & open, with a refreshing ripeness to the soft, appley fruit & a zesty mousse.	<b>£43.50</b>
<b>Mineral Water (Wales) 75cl</b> Strathmore mineral water in still and sparkling, for use on the tables	<b>£3.75</b>
